

**Student Enrollments In Administration of Justice,
at Ben Clark Center and other college sites.**

In attempting to fulfill your request, I encountered some data problems, so what I am presenting here is information in a slightly different form than requested. Before proceeding, I will clarify that student headcount and student enrollments are different (in that a student enrolling in 5 ADJ courses, for example, will be counted as five separate student enrollments, while the same student would be counted only once if accounting by headcount).

First, I wanted to separate the counts by location, primarily whether they were at the Ben Clark Training Center or at one of the campuses. The table below shows the headcount (that is, unduplicated student count) of students at the BCTC for the academic years listed. Please note that the 2006-07 year includes students only enrolled through the Winter 2007 semester.

The table below shows the enrolled spaces that were taken at the BCTC for the same time periods. Please note that this is a *duplicated* student headcount, which accounts for the higher counts. Arguably, this is a more accurate representation of the students served, since headcount tends to underestimate the services provided. In the Headcount table (above) if ADJ served a student 3 times during a single academic year, it would be only recorded once. In the Enrolled Spaces table below, the each enrollment would be counted. (Again, the counts for 2006-07 represent a partial year.)
